ACE is excited to recognize Nathan Plichta and his team of West End Cannabis Co., located on Highway 17 in Vermilion Bay as our feature business this quarter.

Nathan is from Red Lake and opened his original retail location in 2020 which was the first retail cannabis store in Red Lake. The store has become a local staple

and sees basket size 40% higher than the provincial average as well as up to 60 customers per day. With such a great response in Red Lake and there being several retail stores in Dryden already, Nathan thought Vermilion Bay would be an ideal place for another shop. After some consideration of locations, the former Northern Lights Credit Union building became the perfect site for the new retail space. PACE was able to approve funding to help with the purchase of the building and renovations needed to pass the rigorous procedures for the approved cannabis retail license.

With this structure being a former financial institution, there were several features of the building that complemented the strict regulations of owning a cannabis retail store. The lay out and original "teller" counters gave an ideal set up for what is required practice in any store of this type. With a double set of doors at the entrance, it was easy to implement camera security for ID-ing patrons before buzzing them into the store. These protocols were all part of the inspection process through the AGCO for operation of a cannabis retail store. Once the license was approved, Nathan completed the renovations including some very fun, unique artwork throughout the shop. His graffiti artists out of Edmonton and Winnipeg had a blank slate for adding the personal touches to the walls, counters, and vestibule. It is truly a one-of-a-kind shop and sure to impress those that walk through the doors. They even have a gratitude wall in the back warehouse listing everyone that helped make this dream location a reality, including a shout out to PACE!

Even if you are not in the market for the products in the shop, Nate welcomes all who want to pop in to check out the graffiti and learn more about the cannabis retail market. His staff are all trained and have the provincially required CannSell Standard and Expert accreditation for working in the shop. This is the highest level of educative customer service around cannabis and the science of it giving them a "gold seal" ranking. Nathan prides himself on having knowledgeable staff ready to provide the best service for the needs of all who visit the store.

PACE appreciates the opportunity to assist with this project for Nathan and his new location and is grateful for his contribution to economic development in the PACE catchment area including maintaining and creating jobs. We wish him all the best for the future and congratulate him on much success in the community. Nathan plans to be an active member of the Machin area including a sponsor of events and activities.
